

ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE CITY OVER THE PAST COUPLE OF YEARS

Phenomenal residential new construction growth in the City— (17 homes in 2015 and 5 as of the end of January, 2016)

Facilities:

- Installation of security cameras at all 3 entrances
- Installation of pocket parks
- Installation of LED landscape lighting at Cassidy entrance
- Welcome banners throughout City
- Construction of city hall facility planned for 2016

Intergovernmental Agreements/Contracts:

- Intergovernmental agreement with Christian County Building Inspections for inspection of new construction/remodeling projects—updated to 2012 BOCA codes
- Emergency management plan and agreement with County for natural disasters
- Contract for civil engineering services
- More detailed activity reporting from security patrol (Sheriff's Deputies)
- CC911 assistance with addressing to ensure accurate information for their dispatch system

Levies and Fees:

- Lowered real estate and personal property taxes
- Lowered trash rates, and the inclusion of household recycling, with preferred provider arrangement with service provider

Utilities and Infrastructure:

- Street resurfacing projects (with no additional funds borrowed)
- Ozark Water—new service connections to improve volume to City
- Inclusions of Casey's into our WWTP system
- Possible installation of natural gas service through majority of City
- Newly installed electric main to replace 30-year old service line in a portion of the City
- Approved installation of residential solar energy sources
- Annexation of 5 acres of land into City (Mitchell Addition)
- Acquisition of additional land at WWTP
- Acquire plans prepared by a landscape architect for common areas

Outside City:

- Widening of CC Hwy and diverging diamond interchange
- Business Economic Development Coalition for Christian County
