

**MINUTES
TAX LEVY HEARING
THURSDAY, AUGUST 30, 2018**

A hearing, for the purpose of receiving comments from the public on the setting of the 2018 property tax levy, was called to order by Mayor Luke Davis at 5:48 PM on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at the Fremont Hills Country Club, 1953 Fremont Hills Drive, Fremont Hills, MO.

Those in attendance were: residents Rob and Darlene Quinby, Ruth Benedett, Toni Wilkinson, John Clifford and Lynn Morris, and Jordan Needham III with Izuno Studios. The city officials present were: Luke Davis, Mayor; Aldermen Kevin Jansen, Alisa Lowry, Ann Littell Mills, Kerry Nelson and Randy West; and Jeanette Curtiss, City Clerk/Finance Officer.

A notice of the levy hearing was published in the Christian County Headliner, a newspaper of general circulation in Christian County. The proposed levy published was \$.6318 for general revenue purposes—no levy proposed for debt service as we paid off our general obligation bond last year. This is the same levy rate as last year.

Rod Quinby asked if the assessments would be changing this year. Odd numbered years are reassessment years; however, construction/remodeling projects could trigger a reassessment, depending on the project. The county assessor, at a meeting last year, indicated they would be reassessing properties for next year.

The levy hearing closed at 5:52 PM.
