2021 Budget Work Session

The Board reviewed the draft 2021 budget message and had the September 30, 2020 trial balance and October 6, 2020 P & L also for review (which were made a part of the board packet). A letter from the Christian County Commissioners, making the City aware that they are restructuring the sales tax cost sharing program, was made a part of the board packet. We will not budget any funds for 2021 from this program. Funds received from this program for 2020 were \$50,000+. Some of the results from the recent survey will be considered for the upcoming budget. In addition to adjustments made to the line items as they were discussed, items for consideration were: sidewalks, curbs on Bellerive, and another internet provider. We will put the budget in the 5 section format for the November meeting.
